



The Political Paranoia Inventory (PPI) Self Test is a new diagnostic tool which screens for the symptoms of political paranoia disorder and thereby assists patients and doctors in identifying the disorder. The PPI is the only self-rated political paranoia disorder scale that assesses the entire spectrum of political anxiety, delusion and persecutory symptoms associated with this disorder.
